All-in-all this is an excellent new edition which I think justifies the claim in the publishers blurb that this is 'more a sequel than a revision'. Although fairly brief it succeeds in being comprehensive. It is highly recommended for readers who want to be introduced to the subject and is essential reading for those already initiated but who want to be updated. I predict that it will prove popular. My review copy rapidly 'walked' after it arrived on my desk and did not re-materialize until several departmental copies had been purchased.
