An increase in the UAR is a predictor of development of hypertension (17), and insufficient control of hypertension is associated with a risk of deterioration of the UAR (18). The UAR is an early marker of atherosclerosis (19) and hypertensive target organ damage in the kidney (20, 21), and patients with an even slightly elevated UAR are reported to be at higher risk of cardiovascular disease (22).
