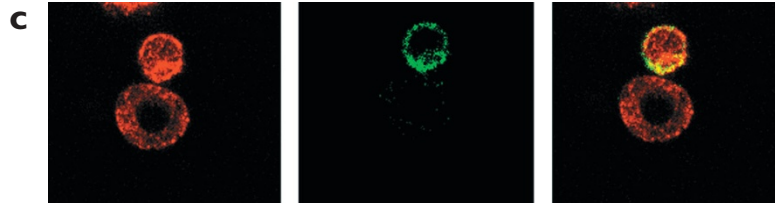


A neuronal receptor, neuropilin-1, is essential for the initiation of the primary immune response
