$$\left(\chi_1^{(3)} + i\chi_2^{(3)}\right) = \left(\frac{\kappa^2}{\kappa^2 + (\Delta k_z)^2}\chi^{(3)} + i\frac{\kappa\Delta k_z}{\kappa^2 + (\Delta k_z)^2}\chi^{(3)}\right) = \frac{\kappa}{\kappa + i\Delta k_z}\chi^{(3)}$$

The correct form of the equation is as follows:

$$\left(\chi_1^{(3)} + i\chi_2^{(3)}\right) = \left(\frac{\kappa^2}{\kappa^2 + (\Delta k_z)^2}\chi^{(3)} + i\frac{\kappa\Delta k_z}{\kappa^2 + (\Delta k_z)^2}\chi^{(3)}\right) = \frac{\kappa}{\kappa - i\Delta k_z}\chi^{(3)}$$
