SWITCH BETWEEN IRRIGANTS QUICKLY AND SIMPLY

Introdent have introduced an inexpensive and easy upgrade for your Piezzo scaler: a free standing fluid reservoir that allows you to switch from water to your choice of hypochlorite, chlorhexidine or something else - quickly and

simply.

Until now, if you used a Piezzo scaler, you either had to have it plumbed in to your water line or have one with an integral water supply. Having a free standing water supply allows you to switch between irrigants according to the task.

For example, water might be most suitable for a simple scale and polish, whereas for a deep scale or root planing you could switch to chlorhexidine. During endodontic treatment, switching the scaler's connection from your water line to a free standing unit containing hypochlorite, using Piezzo type endo instruments, would be most useful for disinfect-

> ing root canals, thereby penetrating the dentinal tubules, actively killing pathogens and removing the smear layer.
