



More Moon Pictures

Pictures taken by the last of the United States Surveyor series of space flights have now been published. The spacecraft landed successfully 30 kilometres north of the crater Tycho, and the picture above shows a wide angle view of a cluster of rocks near the craft's landing site. The horizon to the north-east of the vehicle is formed by a ridge characteristic of the topography of the region, which is in the Lunar Highlands. The picture on the left shows rocky fragments in the highlands, and the centre of the picture is about 5 metres from the craft's television cameras.
