Record breakers!

An Orthopantomograph OP100 unit from Instrumentarium Imaging was recently reported to have completed over 100,000 patient exposures. The standard panoramic unit with original X-ray tubes was operated under warm weather conditions. This record was achieved in just two and a half years of clinical operation.

The unit was installed in Sao Paulo, Brazil in October 1996. Between 150 and 200 panoramic, cephalometric and tomography exposures have been made daily.



Just before going to press, the unit had passed through 115,000 exposures, and is still using its original X-ray tube. The company reports to have an X-ray tubehead failure rate of less than 0.5%.

The basic model features panoramic and TMJ imaging programs, computer-con-

trolled operation, Automatic Exposure Control (AEC) and with operation selectable on either the left or the right side.
