### Oxford International Programme in Evidence-based Health Care, MSc in Evidence-based Health Care

This is a joint Programme from Oxford Universities' Continuing Professional Development Centre and Department of Primary Health Care. It is offered as a part-time course consisting of six taught modules and a dissertation. The flexible structure of the course has been devised to fit with the structure of specialist training and to accommodate student choice. The modules from the International Programme in Evidence-based Health Care can be taken as stand-alone short courses.

### MSc in Evidence for Public Policy and Practice

Evidence for Policy and Practice Information and Co-ordinating (EPPI) Centre, Social Science Research Unit, Institute of Education, London

This MSc has been designed for graduates and policy-makers, practitioners, managers and researchers who want to become more skilled in systematic reviewing and develop a critical understanding of the relationships between research evidence and public policy and practice. Students will be encouraged to build their studies around their own areas of interest. These could relate to social welfare, education, crime and justice, transport, health and health promotion, housing, or any other area of social policy or practice.

This degree can be completed in 1 year full-time or over 2 years part-time. Core course modules are delivered in four full-day sessions, 1 week apart. These modules can be taken as short courses without accreditation.
