

**The Joint Test and Technology Transfer Committee (joint with ASHG) (submitted by Robert L. Nussbaum, MD, Co-Chair)**

The Joint Test and Technology Committee of the American College of Medical Genetics and the American Society of Human Genetics has a number of policy statements approaching final stages of completion. Policy statements are drafted by ad hoc working groups whose membership has the appropriate expertise and experience for each area being studied. After the working group as a whole approves of the policy statement, it is sent to the Boards of Directors of both the ACMG and ASHG for their approval, comments, and suggestions, which go back to the working group. Once the statement is resubmitted, both Boards are asked to approve the document before it is published both in print and on the College and Society Web sites.

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
