

## Pay your ACMG Dues Online! It's Quick and Easy

Make sure your ACMG membership stays active and your GIM subscription continues uninterrupted. ACMG members can now pay 2008 dues online using a Visa, MasterCard or American Express credit card. Go to the new ACMG website at www.acmg.net and log on as an ACMG member using your current login and password. Go to the "Members Only" tab, then click on My Account and follow the directions on the screen. To get a printable receipt, log on to the ACMG "Members Only" section of the website and go to "View/Edit My Profile," and "Events/Orders" button to get a printable receipt for your dues payment.

As a reminder, dues notices for 2008 were sent electronically to all members in October 2007 and are payable by January 1, 2008. All members with unpaid 2008 dues will be required to pay for the current year prior to registering for the 2008 Annual Clinical Genetics Meeting.
