2010 ACMG Meeting Experiences Record Attendance!

The American College of Medical Genetics (ACMG) announced that the 2010 Annual Clinical Genetics Meeting, held in March in Albuquerque, experienced another increase in both attendance and exhibit sales. Attendance at the 2010 meeting was 1,734 (a 4% increase over the 2009 meeting held in Tampa, Florida). Attendees came from 46 states plus Puerto Rico, with 8% of the attendees from 25 countries outside the United States. Exhibit space was also up with 92 exhibiting companies occupying 13,400 net square feet of exhibit space—a 19% increase over 2009.
