(transformed from the covariance matrix), and t is the threshold used for ascertainment.

where  $x_1$  and  $x_2$  are variables for integration over the normal distribution of CARS score for individuals 1 and 2,  $y_1$  and  $y_2$  are variables of IQ score for individuals 1 and 2,  $\varphi$  is the four-variate normal probability density function, *R* is the correlation matrix (transformed from the covariance matrix), and *t* is the threshold used for ascertainment.
