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Corrigendum: Earth's first stable continents did not form by subduction

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In this Letter we omitted to cite a paper¹ that also used recently developed thermodynamic models² to predict the melting process in Archaean metabasaltic rocks. Importantly, the average enriched Archaean tholeiite used by ref. 1 as a proposed source rock³ for tonalite–trondhjemite–granodiorite rocks has a magnesium number (Mg#) of 57, significantly higher than the average value for the CF-2 basalts (with Mg# of 35)⁴. This difference has profound implications for the results of these studies. We regret not citing ref. 1 to emphasize the clear distinction between their findings and those of our study.
