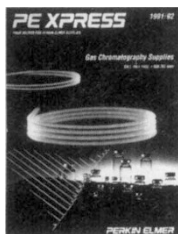

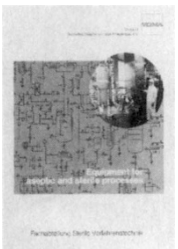

application in the chemical, food, pharmaceutical, and biotechnology industries. Included are photographs and cross-sectional drawings of the equipment, as well as a company profile.

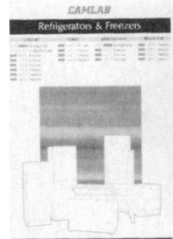

According to the brochure, scaling up from the lab to pilot scale and full scale production is possible using the membrane filters described without loss of reliability or processing time.

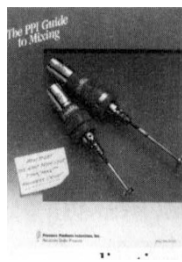
