In the News & Views 'Electron microscopy: The challenges of graphene' (*Nature Mater.* **10**, 165-166; 2011), the sentence introducing reference 4 was potentially misleading, and should have read: 'The structure of graphene has only recently been imaged with atomic resolution. A textbook example is the work by Jinscheck *et al.*<sup>4</sup>, in which the authors employed the wavefunction reconstruction technique in an aberration-corrected, state-of-the-art instrument (see Fig. 1).'
