

Multiple Ontologies for Integrating Complex Phenotype Datasets

ABSTRACT: There has been an emergence of multiple large scale phenotype projects in the rat model organism community as well as renewed interest in the ongoing phenotype data generated by thousands of researchers using hundreds of rat strains. In order to provide ready access to such data, the Rat Genome Database (RGD), ttp://rgd.mcw.edu_ is developing a Rat Phenome Database ttp://rgd.mcw.edu/phenotypes . To integrate data from multiple datasets and published literature, RGD is de debping a Rat Strain Taxonomy 1 and three ontologies to sendardize the major aspects of phenotype records:






