Corrigendum to 'Asthma incidence and accuracy of diagnosis in the Portuguese sentinel practice network' (*Prim Care Resp J* 2010;19(4):352-357)

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The authors regret that two errors occurred on pages 354 and 356 of this article. These have already been corrected in the online version of the paper.

The first paragraph of the Discussion section on pg 354 reads:

- "It also found that the accuracy of the diagnosis by family physicians/GPs was 62% using accepted diagnostic criteria."
- but it should read as follows:
 - "It also found that the accuracy of the diagnosis by family physicians/GPs was 84% using accepted diagnostic criteria."

The bottom of pg 356, in the section referring to diagnostic accuracy, reads:

- "A incidence of 2 new cases per 1000 persons per year with a diagnostic accuracy of 62% suggests that there is considerable under-diagnosis of a common, treatable condition."
- but it should read as follows:
 - "An incidence of 2 new cases per 1000 persons per year with a diagnostic accuracy of 84% suggests that there is considerable under-diagnosis of a common, treatable condition."
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
