





Retraction Note to: Nonsense variants in *STAG2* result in distinct sex-dependent phenotypes

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The authors have retracted this article [1] due to a critical error in the reported data. In the published article, Case 1's sex was reported as male. Reexamination of the data showed that Case 1 was in fact female. As the key conclusions of the published article depended on the sex of the

cases, the conclusions drawn in the article are invalid. All authors agree to this retraction.
