## Correction: NFATc2-rearranged sarcomas: clinicopathologic, molecular, and cytogenetic study of 7 cases with evidence of AGGRECAN as a novel diagnostic marker

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Since the publication of this paper, the authors noticed that there were some minor errors in the text to be corrected, as well as incorrect scale bars in Fig. 1. These errors have been corrected in the original manuscript and Fig. 1 has been replaced with accurate scale bars. The updated Fig. 1 and legend are below.

Fig. 1 Imaging and gross findings of NFATc2rearranged sarcomas, a, b (case 4), magnetic resonance imaging with STIR (Short tau inversion recovery) showing a large tumor replacing the medullary cavity of the distal femur associated with a massive extra-osseous component. Grossly, the tumor was a large fleshy mass with hemorrhagic areas and multilobular contours. c, d (case 7), radiograph of the surgical specimen showing an ill-defined lytic mass growing posteriorly into the soft tissues. Grossly, the tumor manifested as a large destructive fleshy mass breaking through the cortex and invading the surrounding tissues, note the marked periosteal reaction. Scale bars 5 cm.
