
## BOOK REVIEW: PRACTICAL TECHNIQUES IN PERIODONTICS AND <u>IMPLANT DENTISTRY</u>

A quick reference, perfect for dental students with an interest in periodontics, to essential techniques in periodontics and implant dentistry. Illustrated with radiographs, histological images, clinical photographs and line drawings, and starting with a review of biological fundamentals and wound healing, the book takes a techniquebased approach which is designed to enable the reader to quickly find important information. The book's 21 chapters cover such topics as: the anatomy and physiology of the periodontium, including an overview of gingival tissue, embryonic development, and soft tissue physiology; explorations of wound healing; pathology of periodontal disease; discussion of patient examination

and initial therapy; surgical anatomy and local anaesthesia; suturing techniques; osseous surgery; clinical crown lengthening; and the principles of implant dentistry including prosthetic considerations, digital surgical workflow and peri-implant diseases
