Author: Rushworth B (2020)


Comprehensive, concise and designed for daily use, this handbook gives you everything you need at your fingertips whether on the go, in clinical sessions, or for revision.


5. A Practical Approach to Special Care in Dentistry



Author: Wassell R (2018)


Reflecting important developments in the field, this book is a state of the art clinical guide to contemporary materials and techniques for the restoration of individual teeth and implants.
