- TePe Daily Kids (3–6 years) contains 1000 ppm fluoride, with no foaming agents, no SLS and an extra mild minty flavour

- TePe Daily Baby (0–2 years) is suitable from the very first tooth, and contains 1000 ppm fluoride, no SLS, no foaming agents, no colour or added flavour.

The TePe Daily range has been developed with brushing behaviours in mind, with minimal or no foaming agents and a milder flavour than conventional toothpastes. This can reduce the need for rinsing after brushing, lessen the lasting impact on the taste buds and help to encourage a longer brushing time and increase the efficacy of the fluoride.

In addition to TePe Daily, TePe has introduced TePe Pure, a gentle formula designed for patients with a sensitive oral mucosa and dry mouth.

Many conditions (including dermatitis, allergy, autoimmune diseases, lack of saliva) can make the oral mucosa sensitive. A mild or no flavour and low or no foam can be preferred by individuals living with these conditions.

TePe Pure is available in an extra mild peppermint flavour or unflavoured and contains 1450 ppm fluoride for effective protection against caries.

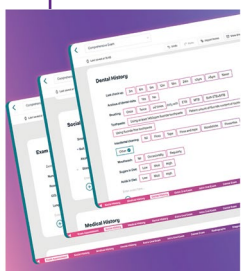
DYSLEXIA AND CLINICAL NOTE TAKING
