Author Correction: Insights and implications of sexual dimorphism in osteoporosis

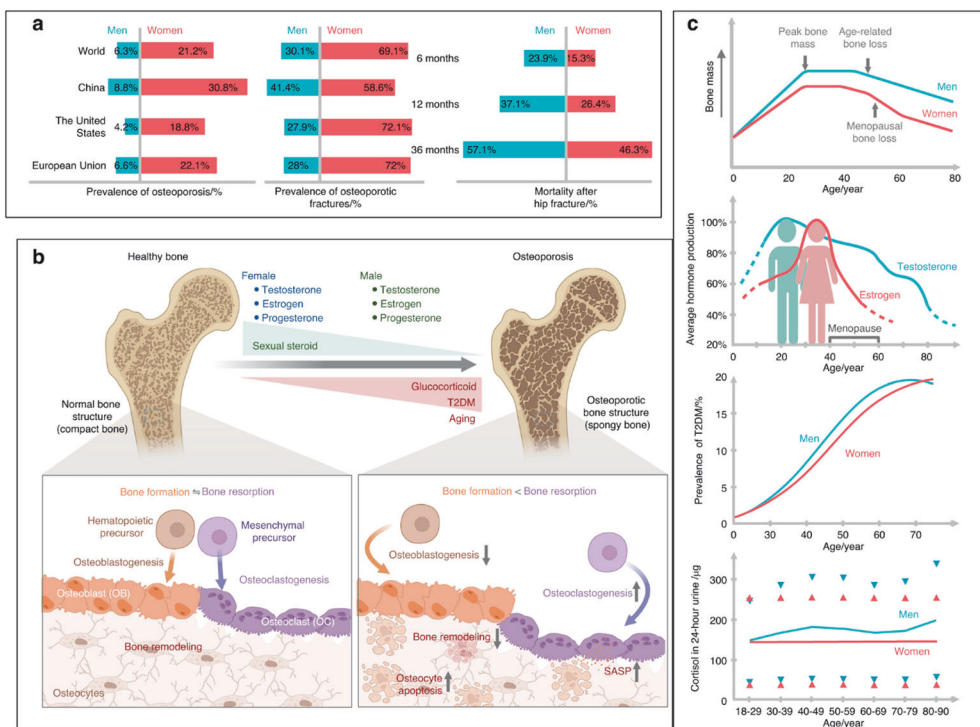

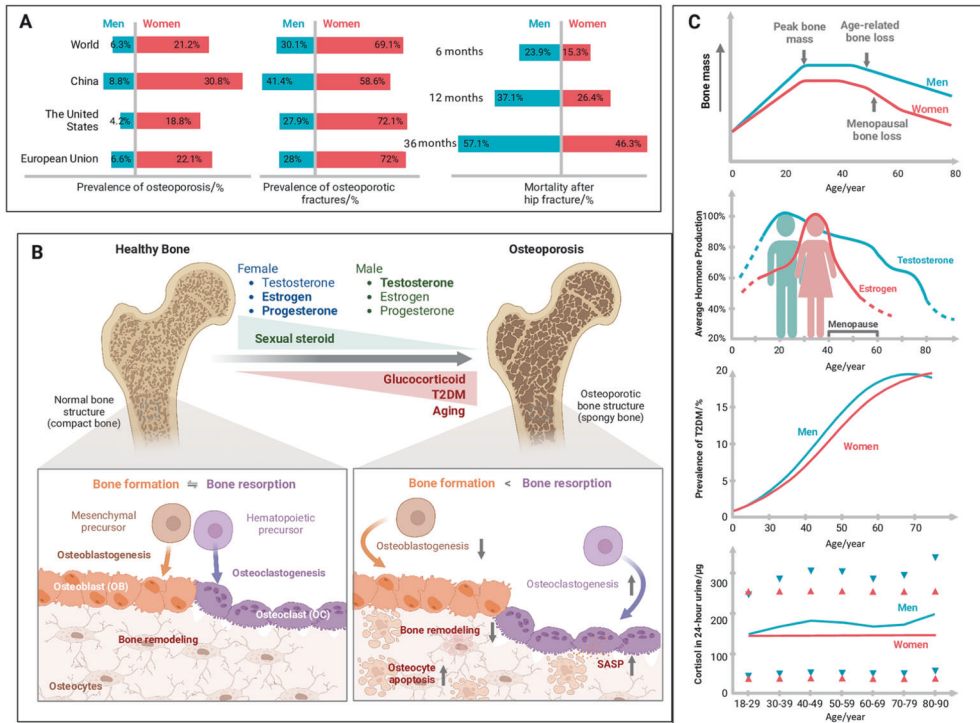
