The original version of this Article contained an error in the Discussion, which incorrectly read ‘Striatal indirect neurons become selectively entrained during  $\beta$ -oscillations<sup>40</sup> with a phase preference that precede STN activity by 45° (which corresponds to ~6 s assuming a 50 ms  $\beta$ -cycle period)<sup>24</sup>. The correct version states ‘ms’ in place of ‘s’.
