The original version of this Article contained the following errors:

In the Results, subsection ‘Phenotypic signature analysis identifies shape determinants’, a protein with homology to PBP5 and PBP6 D, D-carboxypeptidases was incorrectly referred to as ‘ACX60_RS04555’; the protein name has been corrected to ‘ACX60_RS05395’.

Another mislabelling error was present in Figure 5f; the correct version states ‘ACX60_RS05395’ in place of ‘ACX60_RS05685’.

In addition, the colour fill within dotted error lines (indicating s.d.) was missing from Figures 3b, 3g, 4c, 4d, 5d and 5e.
