

# Author Correction: REV-ERB in GABAergic neurons controls diurnal hepatic insulin sensitivity

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We would like to add more information to this Article about the knockout mice used, to increase clarity and transparency. The sentence ‘The REV-ERB- $\alpha$  allele generates a truncated protein without a DNA-binding domain<sup>8</sup> upon Cre recombination and, therefore, could lead to a functionally hypomorphic knockout and/or have effects on transcription that are independent of DNA binding.’ has therefore been added after the sentence ‘To assess the function of REV-ERB- $\alpha$  and REV-ERB- $\beta$  in GABAergic neurons, we generated mice with a GABAergic-neuron-specific knockout of REV-ERB- $\alpha$  and REV-ERB- $\beta$  (hereafter, knockout mice) by crossbreeding *Nr1d1<sup>loxP</sup>Nr1d2<sup>loxP</sup>* double-floxed mice<sup>7,8</sup> with *Vgat-ires-cre* (*vgat-cre*) mice.’.
