After publication of this article, we noted that the *IgM*^{-/-} mouse strain used in experiments reported in Fig. 4j and Extended data Fig. 7l was incorrectly referenced in the Methods. The *IgM*^{-/-} mouse strain purchased from The Jackson Laboratory and used in our study was 002288 (i.e., *IgM*^{-/-} mice lacking mature B cells), and not 003751 as mistakenly published in the original version of the article.
