The original version of this Data Descriptor implied that the Global Biotic Interactions database (GloBi) was a sub-site of the Global Biodiversity Information Facility (GBIF) which is incorrect. It also implied that data sources relating to literature references and location information were unavailable in GloBi, whereas these can be retrieved by changing the parameters in the `get_interactions()` function of the `rglobi` R package. The text in the Methods section has been amended to reflect this.
