






Author Correction: Evidence for large microbial-mediated losses of soil carbon under anthropogenic warming

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In the original published article, the graphs in Figure 2 were incorrectly based on soil carbon density per soil mass, not soil carbon stocks per area as the axis labels indicated. Figure 2 and the legend have been updated to now reflect the use of soil carbon stock per unit area data. These changes do not affect the findings of the Perspective.
