Precision is key when it comes to excavating caries, however, improvements in restorative materials mean that it is often difficult to see the margin between healthy tooth structure and common restorative materials.

The Fluoresce HD Dual Wavelength Coupling makes caries detection and removal easier as well as minimising the risk of removing healthy tooth structure.

During caries removal, the UV light causes porphyrins inside caries to fluoresce orange/red (and healthy tooth light green). The UV light also causes restorative materials such as resins, cements etc to appear a different colour.

Since you can see everything as you are working, caries removal becomes 'paint by numbers' simple – only remove what needs to be



removed, leaving healthy structure intact.
